Thanks to the generosity of people like you, the *House of Charity – Bishop’s Annual Appeal* has provided funds necessary to help others in the faith.

- Almost **30,000** people have been served by the Family Service and Community Centers in the past two years alone
- More than **1,200** young people are currently being served through Youth & Young Adult Ministry
- **3** local campus ministries at **Rutgers, Rowan & Stockton** are available for all students
- House of Charity provides support to **Hopeworks ‘N Camden** which empowers **Camden’s youth through technology training**
- Over the last two years, **83** parishes were provided assistance for Youth and Young Adult programs
- In just two years, **285** women received pre-natal and post delivery medical care
- In one year, the Marriage Preparation Program served nearly **800 couples** throughout the Diocese
- **102** successful adoptions over the past two years through Catholic Charities
- Last year alone, **2,577** people received donations from the Warehouse/Thrift Shop – more than double the previous year
- Over **1,300** people received treatment from the St. Luke’s Catholic Medical Services in the past year
- The School Based Family Services provided support to **627** in one county alone last year
